AIM

The training programme will acquaint participants with the underlying logic of industrial policy; the pros and cons of available measures and policy instruments; and methods for engaging business, labour and communities as key stakeholders in economic policy. It will take a practical, hands-on approach based principally on analysis of South African experiences and evidence

The training workshop will address the following issues:

- ❖ The aims of industrial policy in South Africa;
- ❖ International perspectives, experiences and debates on industrial policy;
- ❖ Using value chain analysis to develop sector strategies;
- ❖ Core policy instruments and measures;
- ❖ The role and modalities of stakeholder engagement; and
- ❖ Managing risk in industrial policy.

APPROACH

The workshop will combine formal inputs and readings with interactive sessions that draw on the experience and interests of participants. In order to gain practical learnings for policy making and implementation, the workshop will include group work on participants' experiences in developing and implementing industrial-policy measures.

The workshops will be facilitated by Dr Neva Makgetla of TIPS. Neva has extensive experience in economic policy development both inside and outside of government. She has also led a number of major research projects on the South African economy.
